Who can join Project Give?

Girls and boys in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 living in the HRM area.

When and where do you meet?

Project Give has adopted the residents of The Sagewood Continuing Care Community in Lower Sackville for the 2019-20 year.

Members of Project Give come together one Sunday afternoon per month and give of their time, talent and treasure to bless and build relationships with these precious elders. Each season includes 3 monthly meetings: for example, in Winter 2020, January and February will feature visits to The Sagewood, while March will feature a special event at 97.5 CIOE-FM radio station up the road, where the Sagewood residents will be invited as "guests of honor" to a Winter Tea hosted by the Project Give team!

The Spring season will follow a similar outline: two visits to The Sagewood and a Spring Tea at the station.

There will also be a variety of opportunities to stay connected between monthly team gatherings.

What is the financial commitment for Winter & Spring 2020?

A program fee of \$45/month per child (just \$270 for the Winter and Spring 2020 seasons, January through June) will immerse your child in a rich and mature philanthropic experience, help them identify their individual gifts and assets to the community, and instill in them a boldness and confidence as not just leaders of tomorrow - but of today. This fee will also cover small gifts of love to be given to our new elderly friends - a catalyst for conversation. E-transfers, cash and cheques accepted.
